Software:

Sync Notes on Your Mac with Your iPhone

Download and install **Notational Velocity** for free on your Mac

Get the free app **PlainText** for your iPhone

Make sure you have the **Dropbox** app installed on your iPhone and connected to your Dropbox online account.

Open PlainText

Check your Dropbox folder on your Mac. There should be a folder inside named "PlainText"

Follow the instructions here except change 3. to be the PlainText box in your DropBox folder. Also set that folder under the Dropbox sync info in PlainText on your iPhone.

Symbolic Linker

IMAP vs POP3

Set up your email as an IMAP account and then your phone, computer and the cloud will always automatically be in sync.

Evernote

Clip web pages. Take notes. Take pictures with your phone. Everything syncs between the cloud your phone and your iPad. You can search by text even if it is in a picture.

Delicious

Keep all of your bookmarks in the cloud.

Instapaper

Capture a webpage to read later on your phone or iPad.

DBD – Delicious Bookmark Discovery

Instant access and manage your Delicious bookmarks

GoodReader for iPad

Allows you to read and annotate pdf files as well we read annotations on pdf files you already have. Uses various syncing options including Dropbox.

Notability

Allows you to take notes and record the conversation at the same time. You can touch your notes and it will play back the conversation that was recorded at that instant.
